Comments and Actions

- Members of the council were presented with their badges to proudly display their membership to others! The badges are a rainbow.
- Mrs. Hart explained what being on the council means: we are JEDIs! We fight for **justice**, ensure **equity**, celebrate **diversity** and promote **inclusion** for all members of our school community.
- Mrs. Hart shared that she had been at a conference on Friday with other headteachers to discuss this. At the conference, they looked at anti-racism statements for schools to include on their websites. Mrs. Hart asked the children what they felt was important to include in our statement. The children suggested:
 - We do not allow any bullying in our school;
 - Everyone has rights and everyone is treated equally, no matter what their skin colour is or how they look;
