1.15 - Continuous provision play

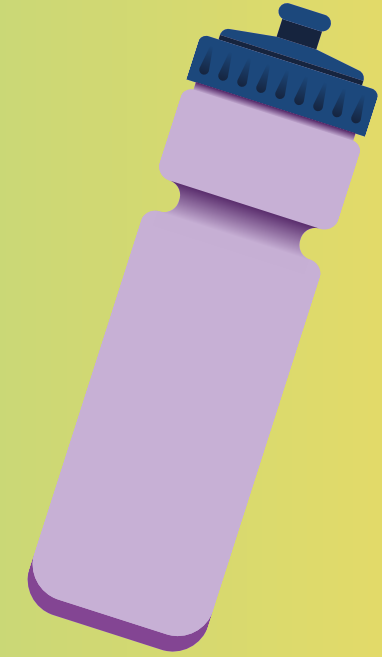
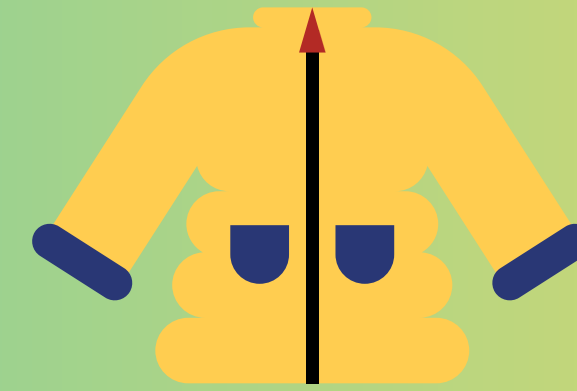
2.45 -3.15pm - Tidy up time, Story time, home time preparation
