What is it made from? Look at the labels in your clothes and write a list of materials that they are made from.

Mental Maths Focus this half term:

- To recognise odd and even numbers
- Rapid recall of number bond to 20 and number bonds to 100 e.g. $40 + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 100$
- Counting forward and back in 10s, 5s, 3s, and 2s.
- Recall multiplication and division facts for the 10, 5 and 2 times table.

It would be great if you could continue to help your child read the time to the nearest 5 minutes on an analogue clock. It is something that needs to be practised regularly as it is really tricky!
