Hexham Library is excited to be hosting ***Make Mine Manga***, a touring exhibition for everyone from those curious to discover manga for the first time to avid fans of the medium. ***Make Mine Manga*** will be at Hexham Library from 22nd September to 10th October and entry is completely FREE during our regular opening hours.

The exhibition explores the origins of manga in Japan, the creative techniques behind the art and the wonder of Manga-Anime, featuring artwork from incredible creators from both Japan and the UK. Created by Paul Gravett, comic publisher, fan and author of 'Manga: 60 Years of Japanese Comics', the exhibition is on loan from the Lakes International Comic Art Festival.

As part of the exhibition programme, we are offering a number of linked events including some with local artist, Lauren Matthews, which can be booked via our Eventbrite platform.
