Dear Parents and Carers

The Early Years Pupil Premium

I wanted to write to you to explain what the Early Years Pupil Premium is, who is eligible for this funding and, importantly, to ask you to fill out the attached form so that we can receive the extra funding.

Since April 2015 we have been able to claim an extra 53 pence per hour for three and four year old children through the Early Years Pupil Premium to support children's development, learning and care. This means an extra £302 a year for each child taking up the full 570 hours funded entitlement to early education. This additional money could make a significant difference to us and your child.

We can use the extra funding in any way we choose to improve the quality of the early years' education that we provide for your child. This could include, for example, purchasing quality resources, additional training for our staff, investing in partnership working to further our expertise, and/or supporting our staff in working on specialised areas such as speech and language.

It is well documented that high quality early education can influence how well a child does throughout their school life, so we do want to make the most of this additional funding in order to better support your child to meet their full potential.

We are therefore asking that ALL PARENTS/GUARDIANS who believe that they may be eligible to fill in the attached form. In supporting us to receive this additional funding you really are supporting your child to receive the very best early education at our provision!

Three and four year olds will also be eligible if:

- they are currently being looked after by a local-authority in England or Wales
- they have left care in England or Wales through an adoption
- they have left care in England or Wales through a special guardianship order or a child arrangement order
