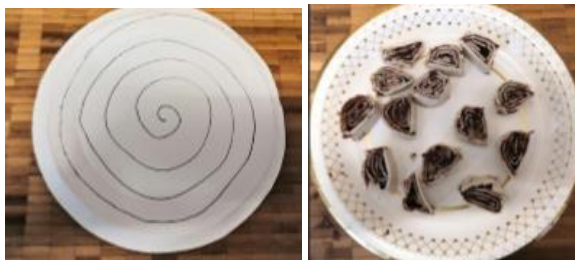

Spiral patterns

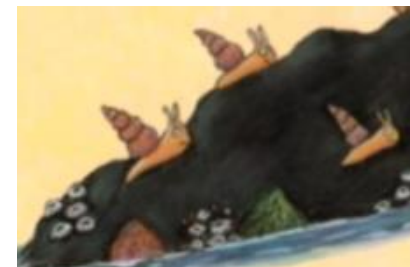


Can you make a spiral pattern?
