Year 2 – Bring a parent/carer to lunch – Wednesday 15 November – if you have not already replied and would like to attend please contact the school office as soon as possible.

Road Safety – Road safety workshops will be delivered to each class on Tuesday 21 November. As the dark nights set in we will be reminding the children all about staying safe. We continue to rely on your support when asking you to park considerately, and in safe marked areas. This will help to reduce risks and danger to our children during the busy morning and afternoon drop off times.

Vision Testing – did you know that the NHS recommends children have their vision tested every two years? This test is free for all children under the age of 16. If you do take your child for a test ask for a Colour Vision Deficiency (CVD) test. CVD affects the way a person perceives colour. The NHS does not routinely include a CVD test and the Northumberland Sensory Support Service is concerned that there may be a large number of children and young people in schools with undiagnosed CVD. A child who is diagnosed with CVD can then be given the educational support needed.
