











EYFS Digging Deeper Maths Challenges

Liz has a number in between. What number could it be? Is there more than 1 answer?</p>  	<p>3. A pirate has 15 coins some are silver and some are gold draw what his treasure might look like. How many different ways of drawing his treasure can you find? Is there a way of organising your drawings to check you found all the possibilities?</p> 
<p>4. When you roll two dice, what's the highest number you can get? What's the lowest?</p> 	<p>5. Work as a family to solve this puzzle! You could make a river and use toy animals.</p> 	<p>6. Cupcake challenge! Imagine you are making cupcakes. You have red, blue and yellow icing. Your toppers are cherries, chocolate buttons and smarties.
