Nursery – is your child eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)? EYPP is extra funding that can be claimed for eligible 3 and 4 year old children who are accessing a free early education and childcare place to support their learning, care and development. We can claim up to £300 per year for each eligible child. We use this extra funding to enhance the quality of your child's early years' experience, for example to improve teaching and learning, facilities, resources and training. Your child may be eligible for EYPP if you receive any of these benefits

- Income Support or Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Universal Credit
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service)
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit (WTC) and the family's annual income (as assessed by the Inland Revenue) is not more than £16,190
- Receive support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The guarantee credit element of Pension Credit.

If you think you may be eligible please ask at the school office or call on 01434 632534 for a registration form.

SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS – ARE YOU PREPARED?

During periods of severe weather there may be school closures or disruption to your child's Home to School Transport. In these circumstances do you know what to do? Here are some tips

- Listen to local radio stations mainly BBC Radio Newcastle 95.4fm; other useful stations are Real Radio 100 to 102fm and Radio Borders 102.3fm.
- Go to the Northumberland County Council Website <u>www.northumberland.gov.uk</u>

The County Council will continuously update news on the front page

In extreme cases a school may have to close during the day due to severe weather and your child will be sent home early. Do you have a procedure in place for the care of your child until you arrive home? You could:-

- Make arrangements with a relative or close friend to care for your child until you are able to get home
- Inform the school and transport provider of these arrangements as it may be necessary for your child to seek alternative transportation from school
- Make sure the school has an I.C.E. "In Case of Emergency" contact telephone number
- Investigate whether your child's school operates an "Emergency Alert Scheme" and sign up to it
- Above all, make sure your child is aware of the arrangements.
