## **Comments and Actions**

- All of the classes have now filled in the pupil voice survey Mrs Hart shared the results with School Council:
  - The majority of responses were positive! Children love coming to our school, enjoy the work and feel safe here. Hooray!
  - Around half of children hadn't accessed an after-school club. School Council felt that there was a good range of clubs on offer and that there is something for everyone. Bella asked if dance could be for the older children and we agreed to make Cheerdance available to Y3/4 for Summer Term after a few enquiries. Bella also suggested including quotes and photos from children taking part in clubs on the school website. Great idea!
  - Year 4 would like more trips. This has been stopped by Covid but Mrs Hart is trying to organise as many visitors into school as possible in the meantime including Paralympian Stephen Miller.
  - Two children said they didn't know who to talk to if they were worried. School Council talked about introducing buddies - Mrs Hart to ask Miss Storey about this.
- Mrs Hart then mentioned the introduction of Sports Leaders. Bella and Liam to ask Year 4 who would like to be trained and run playground activities with the younger children. This will then run alongside the buddy system and give more peer support to those who need it as well as encouraging children to be active and play alongside each other.
