

### Literacy challenges

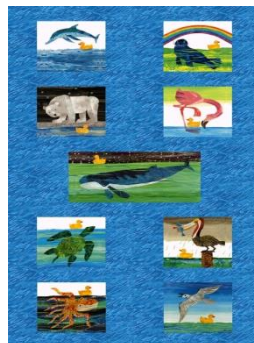
Week beginning 1.6.20
