

<p><u>Literacy challenges</u> <u>Week beginning 6.7.20</u></p> <p>This week our literacy challenges are based on the story, 'The dinosaur that pooped a planet'</p> <p>You can begin by listening to the story. We've suggested these follow up activities to consolidate a range of reading and writing skills previously taught in school.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/hJLWmegE_CE</p>	<p>Monday - See separate transfer day activity menu</p> <p>Speech bubble writing Decorating the number 6 Record a message asking a question about year 1!</p>	<p>Tuesday - Tricky word Tuesday</p> <p>Using the words What, have, said, all, was, me, my, her, she, we, be, (or any other words previously taught that you think your child needs to practice!)</p> <p>Make your own bingo card by writing a range of the tricky words on a bingo board and get playing.</p> <p>Alternatively visit: https://myfreebingocards.com/... and follow the instructions to make an online version - no printer needed. (You can send links/bingo cards to other households to host a virtual family bingo game!) My family have used this quite a lot as an alternative to a weekly quiz!</p>
<p>Write it Wednesday</p> <p>Write the following sentences on paper and read it together using different voices (shouting, angry, whisper, singing, laughing, sad, etc) Track the words with your finger as you read.</p> <p>What can we do today? We can go to space.</p> <p>Cover a word and ask them to write the word that is missing. Repeat with other words. Read the sentence together then hide it completely. Now ask them to write it on their own! Repeat with sentences of your own.</p>	<p>Thursday - What did you see?</p> <p>Imagine that you went on a journey on a space rocket - what did you see? Write about your adventures!</p> 	<p>Friday - What do you know about the planets?</p> <p>Research the solar system and write a list of the planets. You might want to take this further by making your very own information book?</p>
