Happy Shoesday and raise funds for Christian Aid – Tuesday 17 May 2016

Walk to School Week and Christian Aid Week are both taking place during week commencing 16 May 2016. On Tuesday 17 May we would like to ask the children and staff to wear their happiest shoes to school and donate £1 to Christian Aid. The children can wear their brightest shoes or brighten up their shoes with jazzy laces, or bling up their trainers or wellies or just wear the shoes that make them happiest! We would also like to encourage as many of you as possible to walk to school that day. We will try to arrange a place where we can all meet – perhaps the school allotment – and walk into school together. We will send out further information nearer the time.

Year 4 Rocket Science! On 2 September 2015, two kilograms of rocket seed travelled from Baikonur, Kazakhstan on the Soyuz 44S rocket to the International Space Station. The seeds were stored in microgravity by Tim Peake (the first British ESA astronaut) before their return to Earth this spring. Schools have now received one red packet and one blue packet of rocket seeds – one of these packets contains the seeds that travelled to space and the other contains seeds that remained here on Earth. Year 4 planted both sets of seeds earlier this week and they are looking forward to measuring and recording similarities or differences in plant growth between the two seed packets. At the end of the experiment they will be entering their results into the national database where the findings will be analysed and published for everyone to see. We'll give you an update later on in the term as to how the seeds are doing and which pack our children think contain the space seeds!



Sun Protection
