Last week all of our children took part in our 'Take One Picture' whole school curriculum event. The challenge was for each class to use Uccello's image of Saint George and the Dragon imaginatively in the classroom to develop their skills across all curriculum areas. Creative aspects of learning including art, music and literacy were explored thoroughly and the image was also used to focus our learning in more unexpected areas such as maths, Science and PE! The work produced by each class is now being collated into a huge frieze that will be displayed in the school library. I can't wait to see the finished result – look out for photographs on the website soon.

Walking round school earlier this week, I was really impressed at our children's enthusiasm and interest in their learning. Reception children are very busy finding out about all the different types of bees and they are engrossed in watching their caterpillars grow – we are all looking forward to the butterflies. Year 3 are taking part in science experiments as they learn about forces and magnets and the 3D volcano they are building as part of their Explosive Earth topic is increasing in size every day! Just a few of the many activities I have seen this week. They learn through creative and inspiring lessons for which I thank all of our teachers.
