

Friday 18 March 2016 – Fund Raising ‘EGGstravaganza’ for

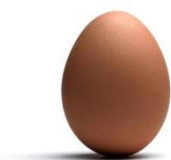
Sport Relief and the British Heart Foundation

Sport Relief - £1 donation
