- Reusable packaging in packed lunch survey - how much waste are we producing from packed lunches and then explore other possibilities if needed. Possible parent session led by Goal Keepers?
- Milk packaging - straws and wrappers can pose a problem, is there an alternative?
- School Fete stall idea (designing and making beeswax napkins - Mrs Burton contact Broomley to explore how they did this/is it cost effective?)
