### Primary Curriculum Driver: MD (Mathematical Development)

#### Intended outcome:

- Count up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item
- Selects the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects
- Orders two or three items by length or height
- Orders two items by weight or capacity
- Uses familiar objects and common shapes to create and recreate patterns and build models


#### **Proposed learning opportunities:**

#### Secondary Curriculum Driver: L (Literacy)

#### Intended outcome:

- Describes main story settings, events and principal characters
- Hears and says the initial sound in words
- Links sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet
- Gives meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint
- Language and emerging writing in the role play dinosaur museum.

#### **Proposed learning opportunities:**

- Provide a variety of fiction and non-fiction dinosaur books in a dinosaur-themed role play.
