




<p><u>Topic challenges</u> <u>Week beginning 18.1.21</u></p> <p>This week our topic challenges are based on our topic "Long, long ago: Dinosaurs"</p> 	<p><u>ICT Activity</u></p> <p>Watch or read the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/75NQK-Sm1YY</p> <p>Using the sequencing pictures (if you can print them out) cut them up and put them in the correct order. (Keep for week 3)</p> <p>Go through the order of the story together, discussing what happens next and checking the pictures are sequenced correctly.</p> <p><i>Alternatively (if you don't have access to a printer) discuss the story and try and remember what happened next, maybe use objects to represent the number of fruits etc e.g., 4 x Lego bricks instead of 4 strawberries.</i></p>	<p><u>Every person is unique and valuable</u></p> <p>Talk about occasions when things have happened in your life that has made you feel special. Find one or two photos at home of a special event and discuss it/them with your grown up. What you are doing in the photo and why is it a special time in your Life. Draw a picture of a special event in your life and with a grown up's help, write a short sentence about it. For example, It was my birthday, We went to the beach, I had a big cake.</p>
<p><u>Dinosaur Skeletons</u></p> <p>Using cotton buds, glue and paper (a dark colour like black or dark blue would work best for this). Create pictures of dinosaur skeletons using the cotton buds as the bones. You could look at the dinosaur skeleton photos I have attached for ideas.</p> 	<p><u>Cooking Challenge</u></p> <p>Make chocolate cornflake dinosaur nests with a grown up. You could even add mini chocolate 'dinosaur' eggs. A lovely way of exploring the changes that take place when melting chocolate.</p> 	<p><u>Listening and singing Challenge</u></p> <p>EYFS: Listen and Play - Dinosaurs - BBC Teach</p> <p>Use the link above to listen to Cat as she encourages you to listen carefully and to recognise and identify various sounds: <i>jungle sounds, dinosaurs roaring, stomping sounds</i>. Cat then invites you to join in with stomping, stamping, dinosaur actions and loud roaring sounds as you listen and sing along.</p>
