8:50am

Doors open, staff available to speak to parents and carers.
Self-registration.

Your child will be allocated a key worker. Nursery staff work as a team and therefore you can talk to any member of staff with confidence.

If children are late and the gates are locked parents must take the children to the office to ensure they have a mark in the register. Office staff will bring the children down to the classroom.

9.00am

11:50am

One member of staff will open the door and another will remain with the children. The children will be dismissed to known adults.
