There will be lots of traditional stalls too – tombola, plant stall, face painting, cake and refreshments. We are also looking forward to seeing Molly Stroyan perform with the children from our school who attend Thursday after school dance club and there will be dance demonstrations by Youth Dance Tynedale.

**Raffle tickets** – we'll be sending home raffle tickets soon – we've lots of amazing prizes donated by local businesses and attractions - it's always one of the high spots of the fete when we make the draw and find out who has won this year's goodies!
