Education in the West

Over the past couple of weeks Andrew Neal, the Chair of Governors, and I have attended Northumberland County Council led meetings and Hexham Partnership meetings in relation to an initial consultation regarding the future of education here in the west of Northumberland. The Hadrian Learning Trust have posted their Initial Consultation Report which is live on their website. It reports the majority of responses were against their proposal of closing Hexham Middle school and changing their age range to become a secondary school, thus introducing a two tier model to the Hexham Partnership. Despite the negative responses, they have declared their next stage is to begin a formal consultation on the proposal. One of their reasons for moving ahead was based on a relative small number of responses. The courant have a "yes / no" poll on their site as to whether they should be moving ahead. The County Council have also begun a consultation, so we appreciate this could become quite confusing. When all information is available, and the consultations are open to you as stakeholders, we will hold open meetings to give you information and answer questions to help you decide how you wish to respond the proposal.
