We will use percussion instruments to create accompaniments and sound effects to stories as well as learning to play different rhythms.


The children will also learn to sing in a round and use call and echo songs to practice developing pitch and tempo.

What can you do to help?

Curriculum Information

Year 2 Spring Term 2 2019 Exploring China



English

This half term we will continue to develop our use of question marks, exclamation marks, commas and apostrophes. We will identify suffixes and use these appropriately in our spelling, especially in tense work.

Also we continue to use stories such as 'Baba Yaga 'and 'The Dragon Machine' to make up our own stories using exciting vocabulary. We will then be writing detailed recounts of the parent lesson and writing descriptive poems about monsters and dinosaurs.

Finally, we will continue to develop our understanding of comprehension activities and working on our joined handwriting from the line.

Computing

In computing this term we will be learning to use the internet safely to carry out our own research. We will also be learning to create simple sets of instructions to direct a computer program and correct any mistakes using the term 'debugging'.



This half term we will be looking at the history behind Chinese New Year as well as studying famous stories from Chinese culture.




Geography



During this half term we will compare the UK with China. We will be able to describe where China is and locate the country on a world map. We will compare what life is like in the UK and China including the physical features, climate and food that people eat. We will develop our use of geographical vocabulary and use it to describe parts of the UK, China and areas around the world.

Maths

In Maths this half term we wi be using our maths skills to solve number problems involving money.



As well as this we will be collecting data about our favourite Chinese foods and we will create a pictogram to show our findings.

All our homework this half term will be based around time. Help your child by reading to the time to the nearest 5 minutes from a clock face.

Science

We will complete our materials unit this half term; the children will be investigating waterproof materials. We will then move on to studying plants. We will compare and grow different types of seeds, as well as looking at the plants and the fruit they produce. The children will name the parts of a plant and investigate what conditions the plants need to grow in. Also our observational skills will be used to draw the inside of seeds and plants that are growing around the school grounds.



We will study the concept of Salvation this half term, learning about Easter and its place in the 'Big Story' of the Bible. We will study Christian beliefs surrounding the concept of Salvation; Jesus showed that He was willing to forgive all people, even for putting Him on the cross. Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans. Jesus rose from the dead, giving people hope of a new life.
