Y1 Visit to North Shields Lifeboat Station & Blyth Beach Thursday 30 June 2016

As part of our seaside topic this half term we would like to extend the children's learning through a trip to North Shields Lifeboat Station and Blyth Beach. We will be learning about safety in the coastal environment and looking at the physical and human features of the seaside.

The visit will take place on Thursday 30 June. We will leave school at 9.00am, returning by 3.00pm.

Clothing

The children can wear suitable clothes of their own but will need to bring wellington boots, a waterproof jacket, sun cream, sun hat and water bottle (preparation for all weathers!).
