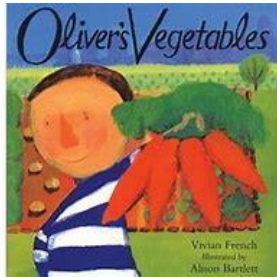


Literacy challenges

Week beginning 29.6.20

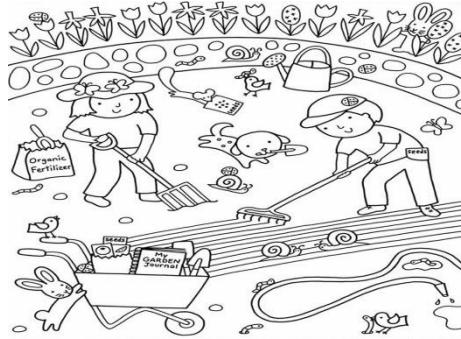
This week our literacy challenges are based on the story, 'Oliver's Vegetables' by Vivian French.

Monday - Design and label your own garden

Which vegetables would you grow in your garden? Draw a plan of your garden and draw and label your vegetables.



Tricky word Tuesday -reading

How many of the vegetable words can you read?



Challenge yourself as you learn at least 5 new tricky words. (sheet attached)

Write it Wednesday

Can you think of a different fruit or vegetable for the letters of the alphabet?



Thursday -

Read letter from Oliver. Can you write a shopping list? Use your phonetic knowledge to help you.



Friday -

Write a fact file about your favourite fruit or vegetables

Where does it grow?

What shape is it?

What colour is it?

What does it taste like?

If you want to, you could make a poster instead.
