Free School Meals

If you think your child may be entitled to Free School Meals, you can apply for this benefit online <u>www.northumberland.gov.uk/fsm</u>, over the telephone on **01670 623592** or by completing a paper application form which is available from our school office or FSM office, NCC, County Hall, Morpeth NE61 2EF.

Why you should still apply for Free School Meals if you are eligible - Since September 2014, all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have been eligible for free school meals under the Universal Free Meals scheme. If you are entitled to claim for FSM as detailed below, no matter what year group your child is in, it is important to our school that you register for this benefit. Where a child is entitled to, and claims FSM, we can register them for Pupil Premium funding – this is currently worth £1,300 a year per pupil for our school. Children entitled to FSM are also entitled to free milk daily too.





COVID PROCEDURES UPDATE:

When a positive case is identified in school – Track and Trace should contact you BUT

- 1. We will share the news with families if we believe their child to be a close contact.
- 2. We would advise all close contacts to book a PCR test.
- 3. If your child has any symptoms at all they MUST isolate until a negative test result is returned.
- 4. If your child is testing because they have been a close contact, **but has no symptoms, it is your choice** if you decided to await the result, but they are entitled to be at school in this instance.

Where school is informed of a positive case – this will be reported to any children's families who need to be advised to have a PCR test.
