In past years, the children have really enjoyed the visit. It offers them the chance to participate in activities such as canoe rafting, archery, ghyll climbing and problem solving.

Thank you to Mrs Dickinson for co-ordinating the disco and to all the staff, parents and volunteers who supported in running the event. We raised the fantastic sum of over £200 and the school council will be meeting to make final decisions on the purchase of a reading den in our outdoor area for all children to access.

I hope that you all have an enjoyable half term break with the children. I'm already looking forward to the second half of the autumn term - it is always an exciting one especially as we get nearer to Christmas and the much anticipated nativity plays.

School Meals Costs (Nursery, Years 3 and 4) – second half of the autumn term 2016 – Thank you to all the parents and carers who have paid and continue to pay on time for school meals. Not only does it help with balancing our school meal registers each week it also saves valuable office time in chasing arrears. The cost for school meals for the second half of the autumn term 2016 is

Nursery\* - 34 lunches x £2.20 = £74.80 Year 3 and Year 4 – 35 lunches x £2.20 =-£77.00

\*Nursery children will have their Christmas Party on the morning of Wednesday 14 December and will therefore not have a school meal that day. Parents will be asked to send their child in with a plate of party food that morning.

If there is a credit or debit on your child's school meals account, your child will have a note home in their book bag today detailing how much you need to subtract/add to the amount shown above to balance their account.

Wellington Boots (Reception to Year 4) ...to allow us to make sure our outdoor provision can be used as fully as possible, please arrange for your child to bring in a pair of wellington boots that can be kept in school. This will ensure that the children can access the outdoor areas and equipment no matter what the weather. Please ensure the wellington boots are clearly labelled with your child's name and in a labelled bag that can be hung over their peg. We would like to start this from Monday 31 October.

Fancy Feet Whirly Wheels – our school will take part in an exciting new challenge with Schools Go Smarter to encourage children to travel actively to school – like walking, cycling and scooting – to help keep them fit and healthy as well as competing with other schools. The Fancy Feet Whirly Wheels Challenge will run for four weeks from Monday 31 October to Friday 25 November 2016. Throughout the challenge, by travelling actively to school at least once a week, each child can achieve points. As well as the children keeping active and having fun, our school will have the chance to win one of three fabulous prizes, with first prize worth £1,000. The challenge is inclusive, so don't worry if you child has to come by car, they can Park and Stride and still gain points; and there will also be points for those who complete a circuit around the playground. We will send a reminder letter out on Parentmail when we get back on 31 October.

Nursery and Reception – 55 Books at Bedtime – the Early Years Northumberland team are running their 'Books at Bedtime' challenge again this year. From the 31 October to the 24 December there are 55 sleeps; they are asking mums, dads and carers to read to their child at least one story at bedtime, every night. We will send out a reminder about this initiative at the start of term and will send home printed forms for you to record your story times. If you take part in this challenge, please return your completed form to us by Monday 16 January 2017. Early Years will hold a prize draw on Monday 23 January where one family will win an annual family pass to 7 Stories in Newcastle and one child from each locality will win a £20 book token.
