**School Meal cost from September 2016** – the cost of a school meal will be increasing at the start of the autumn term to £2.20 (currently £2.10). Mrs Dobson, our cook, provides nutritious and well balanced meals and she has recently developed the menus in line with current advice on healthy eating. The majority of our children enjoy a cooked school lunch and we hope that this will continue.
