## Nursery Funding Declaration 2016-17

All three year olds are entitled to 15 hours free childcare for 38 weeks per year. As you have secured a place at Corbridge Church of England First School Nursery for 15 hours per week ( $5 \times$ morning sessions) we will receive the funding for your child's free childcare entitlement.

During their first week of term at Corbridge First School Nursery the children will not receive their full 15 hours. The reason for this is we believe meeting a family member and seeing your child one to one is invaluable to ensure a good transition into our nursery. Our plans help ensure your child has a successful start and secure induction to Corbridge Church of England First School.

We will ensure the children receive their full entitlement of childcare hours for 2016-17. We will do this by including some planned full day sessions.

Please be aware that whilst we are not providing you with a full 15 hours of childcare during the first week of the autumn term we are unable to share funding for your child's place during this period with any other provider. As stated above, we will ensure that the hours lost during the first week are gained elsewhere during the year.
