Curriculum Information

Year 4 Spring Term 1

Maya civilisation

Literacy

We will be looking at stories from other cultures at the beginning of this term, starting with a Mayan folktale and using this to discuss the characters and predict story lines and outcomes.

We'll also be looking at persuasive writing, using letters and advertisements to explore the kinds of language used.

Following on from this, we'll move to poetry and then stories from past times.





This half term the children will continue to use various apps and programs to create their own 3D world. They will learn about simulation, algorithms and flowcharts.

History



This half term our history topic is the Maya Civilisation. We will discuss various aspects of the Maya way of life including their religious beliefs, gods, social structure, politics, foods and cities.

This will involve using a variety of mediums to create displays and work showcasing our findings and new knowledge.



The children will be looking at electricity this half term.

We will be exploring what does and does not act as a good conductor, as well as learning to understand that introducing a switch will complete and break a circuit.

Most importantly, we will be finding out how to be safe with electricity and what you should and should not do when using electrical appliances.

Numeracy



Starting with multiplication and division this term, we then move to area, fractions and decimals.

We will be reviewing a lot of the topics we have covered in the past few years at Corbridge First School and tying it all together.

We also have a big focus on our times tables this year.

RE / PSHCE



RE

In year 4 this half term we are looking at the Hindu religion and how it is practiced in Britain today.

We will look at the beliefs, Gods and lifestyles of Hindu people and comparing these to our Christian values.

PSHCE

There is a strong focus this half term on PSHCE within school and events to support this, such as Fairtrade Fortnight. Year 4 children will take part in a number of activities to raise awareness of these initiatives including discussion and role play.
