We have had a wonderful first week of STEM fortnight. Here are some updates from the amazing events in all classes.

Reception - Stomping into STEM fortnight!

Wow - what an exciting start to our STEM fortnight. We followed the dinosaur footprints through into class to discover a mystery bag. Who did the bag belong to? Where did it come from? What could be inside? We didn't have to wait very long as our surprise visitor Hannah came in to share all of her exciting knowledge with us from her career in geology. She shared with us lots of exciting fossils, the half hidden tooth was a particular favourite. We then used her fossils to create our own salt dough fossils.

We had two other main tasks this week. We discovered dinosaurs that were trapped in ice and each team explored different techniques to help free them. We then made a warm nest for our dinosaurs to snuggle into.

Our final task this week was to design a boat to escape the dinosaur island with an erupting volcano. We thought about which materials to use to make it strong and waterproof, how the boat will be powered and what else our boats would need. We can't wait to make our boats and see what else is in store next week!

Year 1: Operation Space Rescue

NASA has asked Year 1 to help them get Astronaut Alex Cooper back to earth after his rocket broke down, leaving him stuck in space. Our young space heroes accepted their NASA mission and decided that we must make a new rocket for Astronaut Alex. They got straight to work testing which materials would sink or float as well as testing which material would be waterproof. Now our science investigations are complete, the children are ready to use their findings to design and make a rocket next week.

As well as this the children were blown away to find out that an alien had landed at our school, and even better, was hiding in our classroom for a couple of days! The children received a postcard from Zorg the alien and have begun to plan writing a story about Zorg's adventures!

Year 1 would love to say a BIG thank you to the STEM ambassadors we welcomed into our classroom! They thoroughly enjoyed being mini architects and creating a house for a lego figure. It was truly amazing to see how creative all of our children were. As well as this, they got to learn about the work of a radiographer. They examined x-rays and felt how heavy their protective uniform is.

We are so looking forward to another amazing week full of exciting and creative activities!

Year 2: 3 2 1 Go!

Our racers entered the Rainbow Road on Monday ready for their race themed challenges. They were immediately tasked with the job of moving a car without touching it, which resulted in many different methods, all very creative.

As our week continued, we looked at how we can make the best racing car out of recycled materials and made them battle it out for the top spot.

We have been carefully collecting and plotting our data from our experiments/races on tally charts and block charts, to ensure we will be able to see the overall winner. Next week gets even busier for year 2, so we better have a big rest this weekend.

Year 3: Greetings from our Jedi Training Facility!

Our Jedi Younglings entered school full of excitement on Monday and were immediately enrolled into the Jedi Training programme and given their official Star Wars names.

In directed science lessons this week, Year 3 have been investigating magnetism: Do magnets always attract one another? Are all magnets the same strength? From this they have selected the strongest magnet to use in their diorama/labyrinth. I can't wait to see their final piece coming together next week - may the force be with you!

We have had a great start to our exciting visits this week: thank you Leigh for coming in to share your expert knowledge; we love learning about areas of STEM from the experts themselves.

Year 4: Wingardium Leviosa!

Witches and wizards entered school full of excitement on Monday and were immediately sorted into their houses by the Sorting Hat and given their official wizard names. Hedwig had delivered letters from Dumbledore asking the children to create Mandrake Silencers for the Herbology Department at Hogwarts.

The children got straight to work with their STEM partners, creating designs for structures, using 3D shape nets to make prototypes and identifying the best soundproofing materials.

As well as this, Year 4 took part in the whole school "Curly Wurly" Science investigation, they made predictions and recorded their results in a table and on a bar graph! Can you believe the winning team stretched their curly wurly an impressive 2.10 metres!

Thank you to Mark Warland, one of our parent STEM ambassadors, who visited us at Hogwarts this week to teach us about the life of stars! You really inspired us all!
