I love eating the herring I catch. Sometimes I have it barbecued. My favourite way to eat it is with rice.



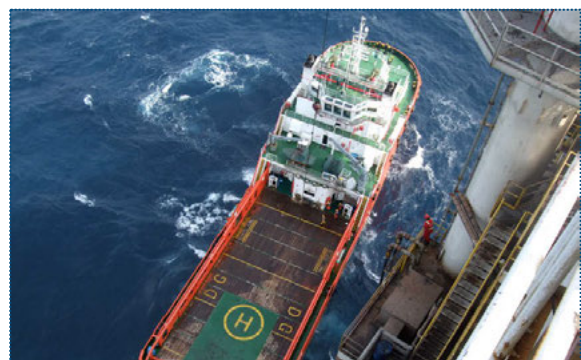
My name is Jill. I work on an oil rig in the North Sea.
