

Home Learning Weekly Menus – Summer Term

As our schools continue to be closed to the vast majority of pupils we want to ensure all families have some support for home learning in whatever form that may have in your home. We have shared lots of information with you and will continue to do so. **Our advice is to do ‘little and often’ and don’t forget to mix school work with fresh air in the garden, exercise at home and learning new skills.**


We will provide the equivalent of daily Maths and English activities as well as a bank of other weekly curriculum activities which you can dip in and out of.

There is no checklist or timetable for families to follow – this would be impossible when trying to juggle multiple children and working from home!

It may be that as parents/carers you are taking it in turns to be with your children so you only have a morning/afternoon/2 hours each day etc. to spend on home learning. You do not need to do all of these things, please be kind to yourselves and pick and choose from the weekly ‘menu’ according to what suits your situation.

Use the video guidance to support your child as they work through an activity. 	<p>English</p> <p>In this week's English lessons you will be learning about non-fiction information texts – enjoying reading them and planning your own text.</p> <p>Also on the Year 1 page are some spellings you could practise.</p>
1	<p>Ordering numbers</p> <p>Practical Option: Choose three numbers (0-100). Using, paint, crayons or even chalk outside write the numbers in order from smallest to greatest then repeat with numbers greatest to smallest.</p>	<p>Today you are going to be reading an information text all about TIGERS. Read the text – independently or with a grown up.</p> <p>Answer the questions – on the sheet or in your home learning book. Have you any questions of your own about Tigers? You could look up the answers on the internet with a grown up.</p>
2	<p>Recognising coins</p> <p>Practical Option: Ask a grown up in your household if you can look at some coins (1p, 2p, 5p 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, £2). You could play a recognising game: your grown up chooses 3 coins and asks you to pick the correct coin. E.g. which coin is 20p</p>	<p>Today you are going to be reading an information text all about SHARKS. Read the text – independently or with a grown up.</p> <p>Answer the questions – on the sheet or in your home learning book. Have you any questions of your own about Sharks? You could look up the answers on the internet with a grown up.</p>
3	<p>Recognise notes</p> <p>Practical Option: See the above activity but use notes instead (£5, £10, £20)</p>	<p>Read the information text about elephants.</p> <p>Circle the title in pencil Circle the subheadings in red Circle the technical elephant words in blue Circle the general introduction information in yellow</p>

4	Counting in coins Practical Option: Next time you go to the shops with an adult you could help them to count their money to pay for their items. Or you could pay for an item yourself! 	Today you are going to start planning your own information text on an animal or a topic of your choice. When you have chosen what you would like to write about you could do some research on the internet or from books to find out more and start writing some ideas on the planning sheet. Just write words/short facts onto the planning sheet – you will write them into full sentences next week when you write up your report.
5	Maths Challenge Practical Option: Friday Maths Challenge	Today you will complete your research and planning sheet – ready to write your information report next week.

Weekly Activities	
R.E	Today you will be learning about the Bible story – Jesus Heals The Blind Man. Talk to a grown up about your senses and what life without sight would be like. You could blindfold someone and ask them to carry out a task that they would usually depend on sight for, for example writing their name or drawing a picture. Set them challenges and compare their results with how they complete a challenge with sight. Read the story from the power point and practise re-telling it orally. Challenge – you could re-tell the story in your home learning book.
