Art / Design & Technology

We will learn how to use natural resources found in our local environment to support our work and will study a notable artist from history, comparing their work to that of a modern day artist.

Curriculum Information

Year 4 Autumn Term 1

All Around the World!

Literacy

The children will be learning about fables this half term having a go at writing their own. We will use Aesop's fables as a basis for drama, and developing the children's ideas for their own stories.

We shall also be looking at and appreciating poetry, creating images and developing descriptive language.

Throughout the term we shall continue to look at developing our use of vocabulary, punctuation and grammar.

ICT

In ICT we will be focusing on staying safe when using a variety of different technologies.

We will use software to develop our word processing skills and also to do research and present information about our Geography topic.

Geography



This term our topic is 'All Around the World!' We will be learning to name, identify and label the continents, Oceans and Countries of the World, especially those in Europe. The children will independently research a country of their choice.

We will also learn about using atlases, including features such as lines of latitude and longitude, and time zones across the world. We will also look at grid references, symbols and keys to build our knowledge of the UK and the wider world.



This half term we will be looking

at the wildlife and the environment as part of our Living Things and their Habitats topic. We will use a range of methods to group and classify living things, and create classification keys to help us identify different animals. We will look at the differences between vertebrates and invertebrates, and go on an invertebrate hunt in the school grounds.

We will carry out scientific enquiries including an examination of the impact of manmade changes on the local environment.

We also hope to get out of the classroom to take part in a science workshop looking at the lifecycle of the mayfly in our local area, and to explore the habitats of British wildlife.

Numeracy



This half term we will be thinking about strategies to solve counting, partitioning and calculating problems involving place value and ordering 4 digit numbers. We will also be looking at securing number facts and understanding properties of shape to include 2D and 3D drawings. We will also be investigating and developing our understanding of handling data and measurements to include graph work, scalereading and estimating, comparing and

calculating different measures.

RE / PSHCE



This half term we will be studying the topics of God and David and the psalms.

We will read the stories of David including David anointed as king, David and Goliath, David and Jonathan, David persecuted by Saul, David spares Saul's life, David king of Israel and David gives advice to Solomon.

We will also discuss important values such as friendship, and stories of Christians who have overcome their own personal 'Goliaths'.

We will read the Psalms and use the words and images to explore the nature of God.
