Field including running track</li></ul> <p><b>While numbers remain at 15 or below in each working group, outdoor play will be from 12:30 – 1:00pm all groups in their zone</b></p> <p>If numbers increase and go above 15 in each working group, the lunchtime outdoor play will be split in half:</p> <p>12:00 – 12:30 – First groups</p> <p>12:30 – 1:00 – Second Groups</p> <p>Staff will have a rota which indicates which their key group is allocated throughout the week for lunchtime.</p> <p>There will be different locations for different groups and this will vary according to pupil numbers.</p>	<p><b>THERE WILL BE NO USE OF THE LARGE CLIMBING EQUIPMENT AT ANYTIME</b></p> <p>Nursery will have an agreed rota for the EYFS outdoors – EYFS staff to organise.</p> <p><b>3 Key Working Groups</b> out at any 1 time. 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<b>Access to outdoor areas and toilets</b>	Children go out to play and lunch and return to the building via their work room doors only and access the same toilets throughout the day.	The children do not access school through the music room door.	Eliminated contact at varied entry and exit points
<b>Access to outdoor areas during curriculum time</b>	<p>If staff are intending to use the outdoor space during curriculum time - which is to be encouraged as much as possible - they must ensure other groups know when/where they will be located. This should be indicated on the noticeboard in the staff room.</p> <p>Groups must not occupy an outdoor space within 2m of another working group.</p>	<p>Staff to be aware that they need to indicate in staffroom where and when they intend to be using outdoor learning spaces.</p> <p>Visual risk assessments by adults will be made to inform decisions about safe movement if children leave the room and it was not planned.</p>	<p>No risk of staff sharing the same outdoor space at the same time</p> <p>All groups stay minimum of 2m apart</p>

Organisation: Staff to organise TA breaks and teacher comfort breaks if needed.

Andy Gardner to be on duty from 10:15 to 11am daily on the playground as support – socially distancing (group staff to manage first aid needs)

Each group has a playtime equipment box for their own use only.

Hands washed before snack and lunch and after returning from any time outdoors.

Field area clear by surface – one line of PE cones to be set out for splitting the yard zones at lunchtime. (AG to place cones and remove daily)
