School Meals – First Half of Autumn Term 2017 - The daily cost of a school lunch is  $\pm 2.20$ . The cost of school meals for the first half of the autumn term 2017 for Years 3 and 4 is  $\pm 72.60$  (33 lunches x  $\pm 2.20$ ). Payment for meals should be made on the first day back after a holiday break. Parents can choose to pay for the cost of the full half term or to pay on a weekly basis. Cheques are to be made payable to NCC.

School Meals – Refunds where account in credit for 2016-2017. School meal registers will be balanced on Friday 21 July. Where a child has a credit on their account, the amount will be refunded to the parent/carers. If your child's account is in credit they will have a small brown envelope home with them on Tuesday containing the amount to be credited.
